Our representatives need to figure out how to break the congressional log jam.

Becky Brakke will again serve as Chair of the Silent Auction and Cecilia McKay will serve as event project manager. Please find the award nomination forms in this issue of the VOTER.

LWVTX hosted its convention from April 8 through 10. The Dallas League sent 8 delegates: Madge Cruse, Miriam Foshay, Robin Lederer, Cecilia McKay, Harry Swanson, Sandy Thornton, Nell Watts and me. Immediate Past President Grace Chimene is taking a well-deserved rest and Joyce LeBombard is the new LWVTX President. North Texas is well represented on the new Board with Elaine Wiant (LWV Dallas) as Treasurer, Elisabeth MacNamara and Charlotte McKenzie (LWV Collin County) as Vice Presidents, Julie Espinoza (LWV Collin County) and Diane Gil (LWV Tarrant County) as Directors. One of the items of business adopted is a study on how bills in the 87th Legislature affected voter list management which will be chaired by Robin Lederer. Another piece of local news is that Dallas has agreed to host the 2024 LWV Texas convention. Cecilia McKay has volunteered to serve as the local project manager. . One of the highlights of the convention was the Paint the Town Vote awards dinner. The keynote speaker was Isabel Longoria who was the elections administrator in Houston. Awards were given to Ms. Longoria and Michael Scarpello (Dallas County), Heider Garcia (Tarrant County) and Bruce Sherbet (Collin County).

LWVUS hosted its biennial convention from June 23-26, 2022. 1000+ delegates from all 50 states and DC joined either virtually or in person to attend a panel featuring female leaders in the voting rights movement; march in support of abortion justice at the Denver Capitol building; elect a 2022-2024 Board of Directors; and share our goals for the next two years.

I attended in person and am grateful that I was able to participate in several very informative caucuses (all were also recorded); advocate for more focus by LWVUS on immigration; and was honored to be with and meet others from Texas. Thank you for being a member and friend of LWVD and thank you for being a volunteer!
